



Central West Zone Code of Conduct

All members, coaches, parents and visitors should conduct themselves in a manner which reflects the values and ethics of Equestrian Canada. Anyone who engages in or is party to conduct inappropriate to a show manager, official, staff, volunteer, competitor, or any person on the show grounds will be reported to the Show Steward. The Show Steward has the authority to uphold the code of ethics and may ask the offending party to leave if necessary, and will include the violation in their show report to Equestrian Canada. We believe that it is the right and responsibility of Equestrian Canada to set standards in matters of ethics, sportsmanship and the welfare of the horse and in all matters under its jurisdiction.
